Fr. Tolton Movie on EWTN December 18

Across, the short film about the boyhood of Venerable Augustine Tolton (shown here in our parish hall in August) will make its television premiere on Wednesday December 18 on EWTN. As the largest religious media network in the world, EWTN claims a reach of a quarter billion people in 140 countries.
