### All Souls Indulgences

An indulgence is granted the Christian faithful who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, if only mentally, for the dead. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls in purgatory. This indulgence is a plenary one from November 1 through November 8 and can be gained on each one of these days. On the other days of the year this indulgence is a partial one. *Handbook of Indulgences, No. 13.*

\*The normal conditions for gaining an indulgence apply.

In 2020 and 2021 this Indulgence was extended to the entire month of November, along with other accommodations. These norms have not yet been renewed for 2022.
