From the Roman Missal, United States  
Conference of Catholic Bishops:

"O God, eternal shepherd, who govern your flock with unfailing care, grant in your boundless fatherly love a pastor for your Church, who will please you by his holiness and to us show watchful care. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. Amen."

The above prayer is based on the prayer from the 1962 Roman Missal:

O Lord, we humbly beseech Thee, that Thy immense mercy would grant to the most holy Roman Church that pontiff, whose devout attention for us would be ever pleasing to Thee, and whose sound governance of Thy people would be diligently reverent of Thy holy Name. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, etc.
