### First Sunday of Advent

About a thousand years ago, the following "trope" was composed in honor of St. Gregory, from whom "Gregorian Chant" received its name. It is sung immediately before the Introit for the First Sunday of Advent. In art, Pope St. Gregory the Great (+604) is usually portrayed with the Holy Ghost in the form of a dove, whispering the chant melodies in his ear.

And so the most holy Gregory poured forth prayers to the Lord that He might give him a musical gift from above as songs. Then the Holy Ghost in the form of a dove descended upon him and instructed his heart, and so at last he began to sing this way:

Ad te levavi animam meam...(the Introit: to Thee I have lifted up my soul).
