Abstinence Regulations for Lent

- 1) All Fridays of Lent are days of total abstinence.
- 2) ABSTINENCE - No meat or meat products may be eaten. By "meat or meat products" red meat, from warm blooded animals is understood, including poultry.
- 3) Abstinence binds everyone from age 14 until death.

The obligation to observe the laws of fast and abstinence is grave.

To intentionally disregard this obligation is seriously or mortally sinful.

Nonetheless, the fast is never to impair the execution of one's work or other duties.

Easter Duty

Catholics are reminded of their Easter Duty, the obligation to receive the Holy Eucharist during the Easter Season. This obligation is grave.

In the USA, this time is reckoned from Ash Wednesday, (February 18, 2026) through Trinity Sunday, (May 31, 2026).
