From Fr. Rickert...

I would like to explain further about an announcement I made last Sunday and to put it in writing.

During the Canon of the Mass, specifically, from the ringing of the Sanctus bell up to Holy Communion, *please* do not leave or enter the nave of the Church. Really, you should be inside the main body of the church to make sure that you fulfill your obligation, unless you really cannot be there (e.g., to take care of an upset child). There is a restroom in the area where the baptismal font is, so please do not flush the toilet during this time, either, as the sound can be heard inside the church, and it's not at all fitting for this high point of the Mass.

At Mass we have the Real Presence of Our Lord — Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity — present to us in Person as fully as He was in the womb of the Blessed Virgin Mary and to His disciples when He walked the Earth. *He wants our real presence, too.* That is to say, we should try to avoid any voluntary distractions that diminish our full presence to Him. “Let us put aside all earthly cares,” as the Byzantine liturgy says.

Thank you for your attention and cooperation, and may God reward you for your dedication to Him. God bless.
