A couple of weeks ago, I made a reference to Msgr. Philip Hughes' work, *The Church in Crisis: A History of the Church Councils*. This is available in html format from EWTN's website. Briefly, *all* of the general councils of the Church have been chaotic and taken place in chaotic times. This is especially surprising in regard to the First Vatican Council, 1870, because the final documents from that council are very clear, serene, and succinct. It was a stormy process to get there!

Another excellent book that combines both Church history and ecclesiology (the theology of the Church) is called *Christ to Catholicism*, by Servant of God Fr. John Hardon, SJ. It is very sound and guides the student through the history and the development of the theology of the Church. It can be found at hardonsj.org
