From Fr. Rickert...

Each month of the year is dedicated to a particular theme; for example, the month of July is dedicated to the Precious Blood of Our Lord. August is dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, a feast we celebrate one week after the Assumption.

We are reminded of the Beatitude, “Blessed are the pure of heart, for they shall see God.” Indeed, Our Lady has been so utterly pure for all of her existence that she now enjoys, in the fullness of her body and soul, the presence of God in Heaven.

When we hear the words “pure of heart,” we naturally think of purity, as well we should. But it is important to realize that the purity intended here (I believe) is far-reaching and total: Purity of mind, purity of intention, purity of motives, and so on, to be completely free from guile. It is very good and commendable to observe purity in terms of the 6th and 9th commandments, yes, without a doubt, but if we have any malice or duplicity in our speech, for example, then there is an area where we clearly still need purification.

In one of his sermons, the great Padre Antonio Vieira (1608 – 1697) expounds on the Beatitude I have referred to. “Blessed are the pure of heart,” he says, “for they — and only they — shall see God.” God bless you.
